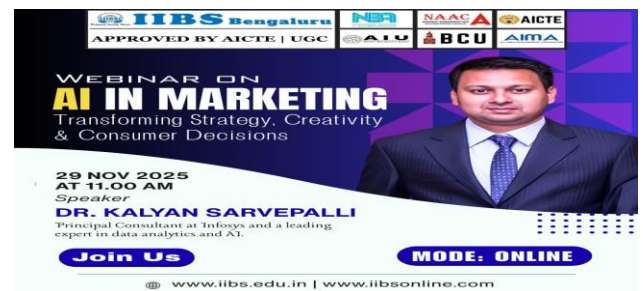
FDP Participation by Ms. Savitha
